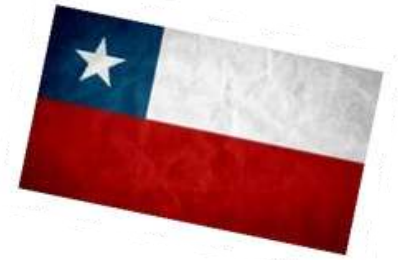

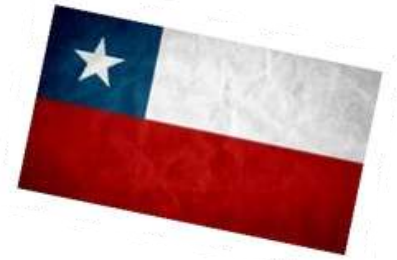

A semester usually consists of 18 credits, except for undergraduate students in Health Sciences Programs (up to 24 cr). For the semester exchange, students must enroll for a minimum of 10 credits and a maximum of 18 credits, which is equivalent to 4 to 6 courses per semester. For the summer term, students must enroll for a minimum of 3 credits and a maximum of 6 credits, which is equivalent to 1 to 2 courses in the summer.
